

## Service Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2020 'The Greatest Commandment'

**Romans 13:8-10** Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law. <sup>9</sup>The commandments, 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not covet,' and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' <sup>10</sup>Love does no harm to a neighbour. Therefore love is the fulfilment of the law.

**Galatians 5:14** For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'

**1John 4:10-11 & 19** say this: This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. <sup>11</sup>Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. <sup>19</sup>We love because he first loved us.
